Abstract Submission Guidelines

1. The abstract presenter must be registered at the meeting. The presentation of an abstract does not exempt the presenter from paying the registration fee for the meeting.
2. To submit your abstract, please go to the website **www.isds2022.com** and follow the instructions.
3. Within 72 hours, you will receive an email confirming the reception. If you do not receive the answering email, please check your "spam" folder or write directly to isds2022@massoeventos.cl.
4. A limited number of abstracts will be selected, some of which could go to oral presentation or a poster format.
5. Accepted abstracts will be presented in a non-competitive manner with other activities.
6. The title of the paper should summarize as briefly as possible the content of the paper and should be in upper and lower case as a normal sentence. Do not use abbreviations, do not include commercial names of devices or drugs, unless where absolutely necessary (e.g. acronyms, initialisms, abbreviations, e.g. DNA, gene names).
7. The authors' names should be written in upper and lower case, indicating the last name first followed by the initial of the first name, the presenter's name should be underlined.
8. The authors' filiation must be indicated individually.
9. The paper should include introduction, method, results and conclusion.



10. A table of data is accepted but graphs and other figures are not accepted.
11. If your study have been supported by a grant, please indicate the source of funding at the end of your abstract
12. Authors must disclose any possible conflict of interest
13. Arial text size 12 should be used, maximum 300 words. Abstracts must be submitted in English
14. Abstracts will be received until April 11th, 2022
15. By May 15th, you should receive an email indicating whether your abstract has been accepted or rejected.
16. In case the abstract has been accepted, you will receive further instructions.
17. We will offer **Young Investigator Awards**. To be eligible the requirements are: a) First and presenting author, b) Must be in doctoral training or equivalent and, c) Must be aged 40 years or younger at the time of application.
